



Safety & Compliance Supervisor

The Safety and Compliance Supervisor's key role of responsibility is managing the compliance of GSC's PNW drivers, the vast majority being Independent Owner Operators (IOO's).

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Manages compliance with local, state, federal, OSHA and DOT laws and regulations.
- Responsible for maintaining GSC Hours of Service records and communication
- Responsible for maintaining and improving company SAFER scores as measured by FMCSA databases.
- Disputes all applicable DataQs from CHP violations
- Maintaining and overseeing compliance of IOO's and company vehicles with California Air Resources Board regulations.
- Updating various compliance data base systems daily with current information (Contracts/90 day/DL/Medical/Manifests etc).
- Communicates all missing DQ paperwork
- Recruit and maintain quality control on owner operator hiring process
- Participate in the administration of grant programs.
- Monitor Subhauler insurance documents
- Participate in insurance related activities, including claims and certificates of insurance.
- Develops, implements, and monitors safety programs to reduce frequency of accidents and injuries; assists in minimizing overall workers' compensation costs.
- Audits various safety program elements for effectiveness; schedules and performs safety inspections; identifies issues and develops corrective action plans.
- Supervises, controls, and monitors building evacuation plans. Coordinates with building management. Maintain compliance of GSC office staff to building rules and regulations.
- Investigates all accidents and injuries; recommends and/or coordinates corrective actions.
- Identifies potential safety hazards at all facilities; reports hazards and recommendations for eliminating/reducing to management.
- Other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS / SKILLS:

- Minimum of three to six years related experience; bachelor's degree (B.A. /B.S.) preferred.
- Experience in managing compliance of container drayage services preferred.
- Knowledge of DOT, CARB and OSHA regulations and compliance standards.
- Commitment to excellence and high standards.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Strong computer skills: outlook, excel, word and other related programs.
- Ability to work with all levels of management.
- Ability to deal effectively with a diversity of individuals at all organizational levels.
